Fun with Biology! Students investigated a variety of science labs to observe diffusion and osmosis and looked at a variety of cells under a microscope.



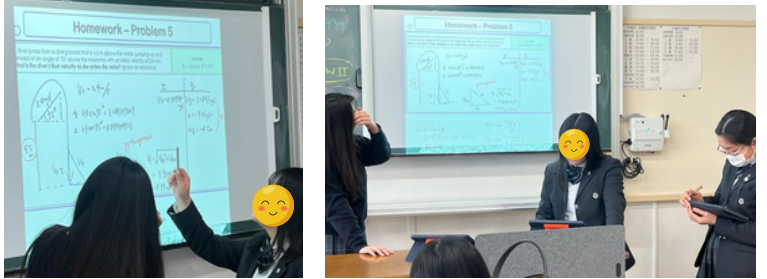
SENIOR HIGH - SOCIAL 20-2

The students from each grade prepared a performance, dance, or video to show their thanks and appreciation to the graduating grade 12 class. Even the teachers surprised the students with a singing performance.



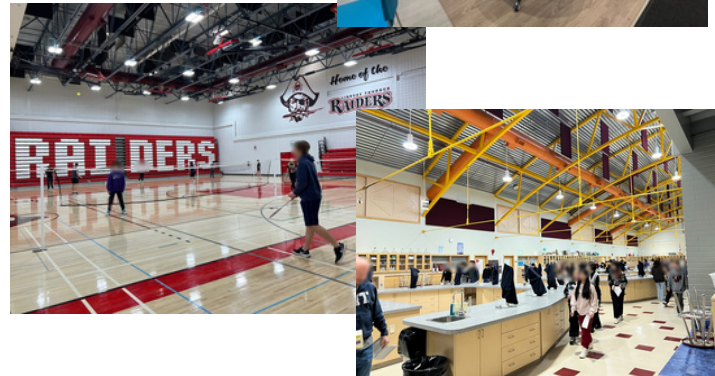
GOODBYE PARTY FOR GRADE 9s
